



Draught of a tract of land lying in the Township of Wyalusing Bradford County and in the old Town of Springfield one of the seventeen Towns granted, &c. Containing ninety seven acres one hundred and four perches and an allowance of six per cent Resurveyed for John Nathan & Harmon Stalford May the 29<sup>th</sup> 1849 in order that they may obtain a patent This draught shows the connection of Several Lots but that which I have Surveyed and for which a patent is wanted Lies within the black lines and covers all the Job Turrell and part of the Wm Smith Lot the remainder of the draught is Copied from an official draft. It will also be observed that the Lines which I have measured do not hold out in length as laid down in the older Surveys To John Laporte S.G. Francis Homet D.S.
