



The draft of a tract land situate on Mouse Creek in lower Mahanoy Township in Northu (obliterated) Dr. Solomon Markley & other lands of the said Ludwig Sanders Containing Two hundred & twenty Acres & one hundred & fifty four perches & the usual Allowance Surveyed unto Ludwig Sanders, the 17th & 18 July 1812. by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 21st May 1812 —

The part of the above Survey west of the dotted line is claimed by Christian Kauble to whom a Warrt issued on the 12 May 1812. Kauble Claims under an Impt of the following description - about 4 acres of land which has been Cleared 14 or 15 year ago and is now grown up so as to scarcely be known it had been Cleared does not appear as there had been grain Raised thereon for a number of years, there had been a Cabbin or rather a pen of about 15 feet square made of poles in which Kauble ~~said he had stayed~~ several knight but was torn down when I made the Survey T. Woodside DS

Ludwig Sanders Claims under an Improvement ^{early} 1777 this Improvement is on that part of Sanders Survey that Kauble does not claim and has the appearance of an old Impt (obliterated) Ground he has also about 4 acres cleared and under fence and Grain Growing there on this Cabbin was put up on the Desputed ground in March 1812 - by Sanders Thos. Woodside
