Being a part of a survey Granted in pursuance w^t four different Warrants to a certain Samuel Jackson, Containing in all 551 acres and the allowance of six per cent said survey returned to the Surveyor Generals office the 23th of 9th mo 1755 the adjoiners in the oridgenal as follows (viz) Moses Ross Adam Cooper & Thomas Cooper William Calbrith & Martain Adams and on a branch of a big run falling into octorario Creek, said above described land is improved and in possession of John Braidy Surveyed by me the 13th day of May AD 1843—
