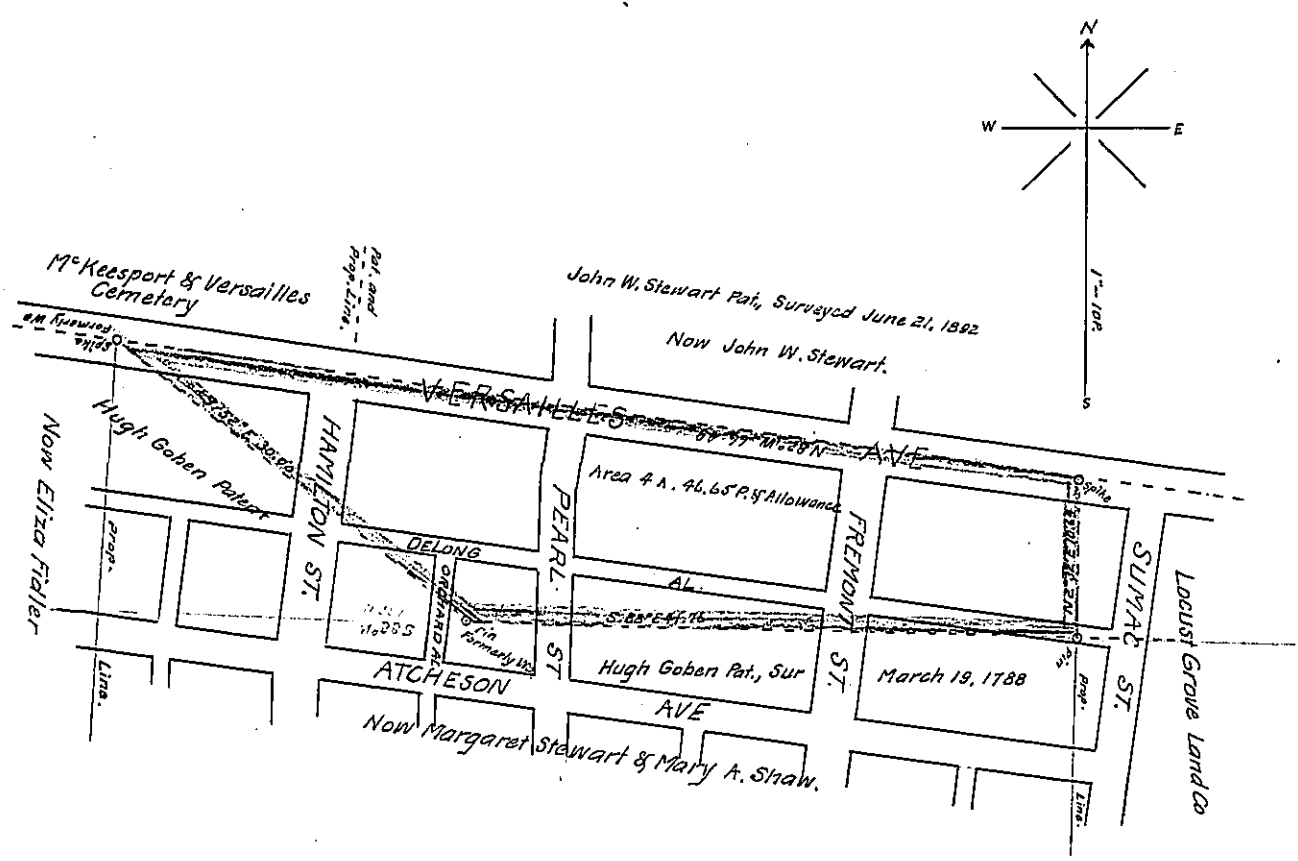


NOTE: - Yellow line shows southern boundary of Jacob Zeinet Tract.

Shaw in their own right and in trust for their grantees the seventeenth day of February 1903, it being part of a larger tract containing two hundred and twelve (212) acres, twenty three (23) perches and allowance, originally surveyed ~~in pursuance of a warrant granted to~~ on Order No. 3344 to dated ~~the~~ Jacob Zeinet, ~~day~~ of June thirteenth 1769.
