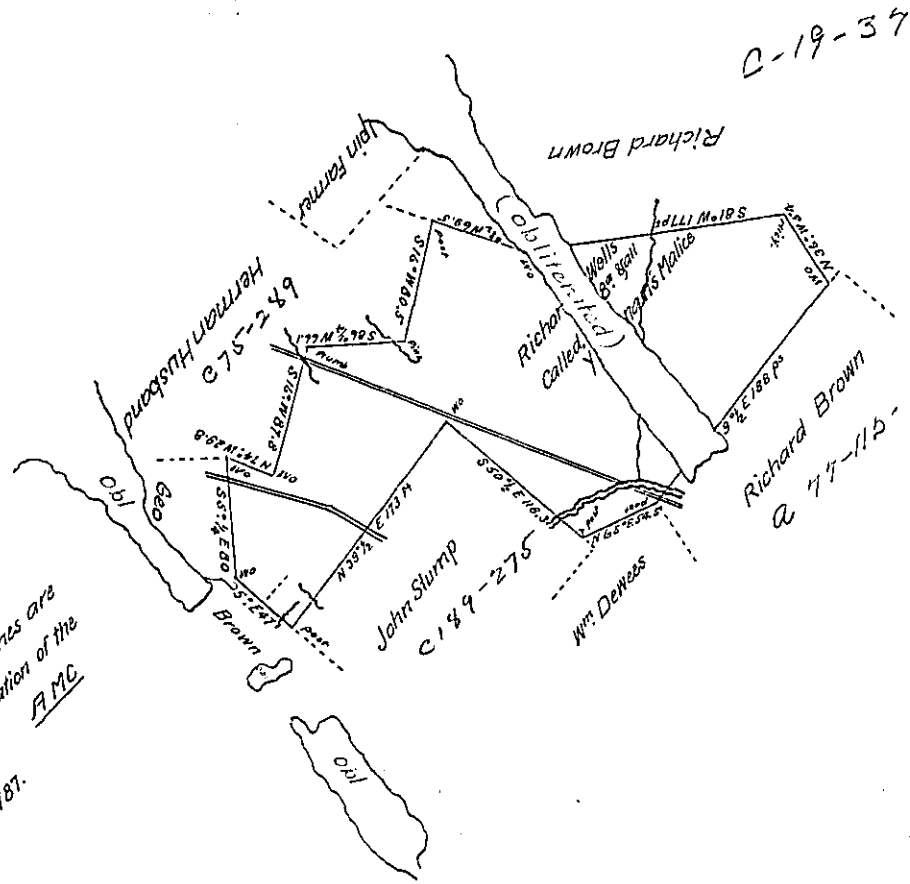


Note. the former lines are altered to the Variation of the year 1787. 7th May 1787. AMC



Situated on both Sides of the Great Roads leading from Bedford to Pittsburgh through Loud's & Jones's Gaps of Laurel Hill in Quemahoning and Milford Townships Bedford County & Surveyed in part in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy five and Returned to the Office in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Richard Wells dated the 21st day of March 1775. But it afterward appearing that part of the Tract Surveyed and returned as aforesaid had been Granted to John Wilson and John Stump by prior Warrants and Herman Husband appearing for them and requesting the same to be executed agreeable to his Directions it was done accordingly on the 31st Day of July 1783. and returned into your Office pointing out the interference by dotted lines also a short detail of the Circumstances as appears by my record - And in Order to enable the owner to patent that part that remained I have distinguished it by its proper bounds adding thereto a small irregular Vacancy chiefly Consisting of Barrons left out by Herman Husband and Rich^d Brown - And as will (obl.) up the deficiency Occasioned by the interference before mentioned.
