



Draft of a tract of land Situate in West Beaver formerly Beaver township Snyder formerly Northumberland County  
 Containing Three hundred and fifty acres, and Ninety seven perches (350<sup>ac</sup> 97<sup>pc</sup>) and the usual allowance  
 of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for the above parties November the 30<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1871. In Virtue of  
 a Warrant bearing date the Second day of April A.D. 1793. Granted to William Stump, Valentine  
 Hepperling and John Rafter for Four hundred acres, the above tract has been improved first about  
 fifty Eight years ago.
