



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Rockland Township in the County of Berks and Province of Pennsylvania Being the equal half Part of a Tract of 137 1/4 Acres and the Allowance That formerly was Surveyed unto Lazarus Weidner in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries Dated on the 19<sup>th</sup> April Anno 1749. Who after the Patent is got out, is to Convey the other equal half Part thereof unto his Brother Tychieus Weidner and to keep the above for himself. — Beginning at a Stone in the Line of Jacob Keims Land, thence by the Same and by Land of Abner Wickersham South 40 degrees West 42 perches, to a stone, Set for a Corner of the Said Tychieus Weidners Land, Thence by the Same North 55 degrees 15 minutes West 224 perches to a Stone, in the Line of John Mulls Land, Thence by the Same North 40 degrees East 62 perches, and four Tenths of a Perch, to a Stone, Thence by the Same and by Land of George Ongstadt South 50 degrees East 223 Perches, to the Place of Beginning Containing Sixty Eight Acres and One Hundred Perches of Land, together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, or Seventy Two Acres and 120 Perches including the said Allowance. Resurveyed and Divided for said Lazarus Weidner on the 16<sup>th</sup> October Anno 1771.
