



The Lines from A to B Represent the Lines of Digger's Choice as run by Thomas Armor and on which all the Pennsylvania Surveys were made or bounded — The Parallel Lines represent the Lines of Digger's Choice as run by William Matthews & Archibald M<sup>c</sup>Clean and which <sup>forms</sup> the strip between them as in this Draught situate in Germany Township York County and surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1793 for Jacob Winteroth and Jacob Hostetter In pursuance of a Warranted for 21<sup>a</sup> Dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1793 I have been thus particular as the parties are Cited to the Board for Trial.
