



Draft of a lot of land being part of an Original Commissioners Road (improved) Situate in the townships of Wilkes Barre and Pittston Certified townships, (now Plains) County of Luzerne, bounded by and beginning at the southerly line of Lot No 3 of 3<sup>d</sup> division of said Certified Wilkes Barre, thence by lots No 3, 2 and one of the 3<sup>d</sup> division aforesaid, and lots No 13, 14 & 15 of the 2<sup>d</sup> division of Certified Pittston township, thence by lots No 15 at the northerly side thereof, thence to the northerly line of No 3 of first division of said certified Pittston township, thence by lots 3, 2 & one of the first division of Wilkes Barre and Pittston and along No 28, 29 and 30 thence to corner of 3 & 4 the place of beginning

Surveyed the above tract of land containing seven acre and ninety three perches to John B. Smith on the first day of July 1864 in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1864
