



By Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the 3^d day of May 1733 Surveyd unto John White of the City of Philad^a Merch^t the 9th of the same month A Tract of Land Situate on a Branch of Conessoge in Lancaster County Beginning at a post at a corner of Adam Goldneys Land thence by the same North 40° West 436 perches to a post thence West by South 553 perches to a post thence South 253 perches to a post thence East 110 perches to a White Oak thence North 83° East 218 perches to a Black Oak thence South East by South 260 perches to a Chestnut Tree thence East by South 150 perches to a Black Oak thence North 40° East 322 perches to the place of Beginning Containing Sixteen Hundred forty seven acres and the Usual allowance for Roads
