



The above part designated by red lines contains 185^{ac} 63^{ac} & allowance surveyed in pursuance of a Warrt bearing date the 16 Feb'y. A.D. 1786 granted to Henry Wagner which had not been returned and at the instance of Henry Wagner son of the Warrantee surveyed it the 7th of April 1824, and returned the same to the Land office at same time surveyed and returned 79^{ac} 26^{ac} part thereof being the part sold to John Pines; also retur'd the long stripe of 17^{ac} 20^{ac} & allowance, being all that belongs to Henry Wagner; the Other part being sold to a Darl Miller, The 14^{ac} 155^{ac} & allowance surveyed on a warrt of the 4th May 1824 for 12 acres granted to Henry Wagner surveyed the 10 inst. & returned pr E Monroe DS. The above Survey on the warrant of the 28 Feb'y. 1775 by the original Survey is 117. 56^{ac} & allowance And on resurvey will now make 146. 141 & allowance by which is gain'd 29. 85 & allowance
