



Draft of a Tract of land (improved) Situate in the Township of Plymouth, County of Luzerne, being parts of two Original Certified Roads; bounded Northerly by Nos One to seven inclusive of the lower tier of House Lots and by other lots as called for in the Warrant and shown on the annexed draft. Containing thirty one acres and eighty three perches ($31\frac{83}{160}$ as) strict measure.

Surveyed the above described land to Samuel Wadhams the 1st day of October 1863 in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 3^d day of September 1863. (The courses are the same as the original survey.)
