Being a part of a larger tract of land originally Surveyed in pursuance of Application No. 4711 for 150 acres granted to George Stahl Dated April 5th 1768 Resurveyed June 5th 1812 and Returned to the Land Office by Jacob Spangler D.S. for and by request of the then owners. And now August 11th 1877. Surveyed as indicated above by the colored lines by request of George Stoke, George Shank, John J. Steidler, John Arnold Executor of Mary Donard deced in trust for the use of said decedent's Estate, and John Evans Executor in the will of Henry Knaub deceased in trust for the use of his daughter Eliza Pillard, for the purpose of obtaining a patent therefor from the Commonwealth to them respectively (they being the present owners and legal representatives of the same) in proportion to their several and respective interests therein which are as follows.
