The above surveyed tract of land, has heretofore been considered, as being a part of Warrt. No 363, Jas. Stewart Warrantee and was purchased as such, by the late James Blair. The Warrantee, whose wife is a daughter of the late James Blair, and who, and the widow of the late Jas. Blair, occupy the land belonging to the Blair Est, has thought it expedient, to apply for the above mentioned Warrant.
