



Surveyed the above described tract of land the 28th & 29th days of December 1836 for William M. Patterson by virtue of his Warrant for four hundred acres dated 21st Dec 1836 Containing four hundred acres with the allowance of six per Cent &c Situate in Davidson Township Lycoming County bounded on the South East by the line dividing Lycoming & Columbia Counties & as above described.

Note the above survey interferes with land surveyed to Joseph Dean as represented by the red dotted lines, I objected to do so, but he insisted on it urging as a plea that Deans Warrant was not sufficiently descriptive to hold the land.
