East from the NW corner of No 166. — the northern boundary line of No 164 & 166 being 412 perches in length, the southern boundary line of No 449 — 409 1/2 ps according to the official returns. The lands on which J. P. Morris has now laid his Warrant, has heretofore been claimed as a part of Warrant No 449, and as such has been bought and is now held by Lorin Butz, Matthias Swan, D. C. Holden and J. P. Morris the Warrantee, as will appear by the dotted lines on the above draught
