



The Survey for George or Mary Douglas was made in Pursuance of two Warrants, one of them granted to Andrew M^o. Dowel bearing Date the 22^d of Febr. 1748, the other in the Name of Mary Douglas bearing Date 27th November, 1752 — Both tracts having been Purchased by David Watt & peaceably held by him for ⁶⁰ Number of Years, & being now desirous to obtain a Patent of Confirmation, as I Survey'd them according to the Dates within mention'd, and believing the case to be clear, I have here represented them in one Draught at his Request Certify'd this 12th of the 11th mo. 1784
