



Draught of a tract of land Situate "formerly in Manheim Township" Now Wayne township Schuylkill County, Containing 72<sup>95</sup> 152<sup>PS</sup> & allowance, It being part of a larger tract of land of 110<sup>95</sup> 99<sup>PS</sup> & allowance which was Surveyed unto George Weidner ("allias George Weigner") on his Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of March A.D. 1750. the above part of the said tract having been granted for the use of a Church and School house, & and is now Surveyed and Returned for Patenting for Daniel Bartolett, Anthony Yeich, and Jacob Rauch, Trustees in behalf of the German United Congregations of Lutheran and Reformed Protestants, Formerly of Brunswick township Berks County, then of Manheim & now of Wayne township Schuylkill County, the former Return of William Wheeler of the School and Church land being made in Error as it left out about twenty acres omitted, to be of the same tract, Resurveyed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1851.
