N° 1 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for David Pressal on Warrant dated the 16th day of July 1821- This tract interferes one Hundred and forty six acres with the Charles Williams survey- David Pressal is the present owner - No 2 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Joseph Cook on Warrant dated the 15th day of February 1775- this tract interferes sixty six acres and ninety nine perches with the Charles Williams tract- Joseph Cook conveyed to Adam Shaver the present owner- No 3 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Col. Henry Boquet on Warrant dated the 7th day of July 1762- this tract interferes Forty one acres and one hundred and fifty perches with the Charles Williams tract- Col. Henry Boquet devised the same to Sir Frederick Haldimond who devised the same to Anthony Francis Haldimond the present owner To Gabriel Heister Esqr S.G. James O Connor D.S.
