The above is a copy of a draft found in my office, with the exception of the red dotted lines, which represents a survey made for John M^e Ghee, containing thirty one acres and eighty one perches & allow^{ce}, surveyed on the 10th day of June A.D. 1872. in pursuance of his warrant bearing date on the 3rd day of April A.D. 1872.

The above survey, to wit: D. Carskaddon, contains twenty two acres, one hundred and twenty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. and from an endorsement on the back, it appears to have been received in the Surveyor General's office on the 11th day of Nov. A.D. 1870 and returned to the County surveyor for correction, as the number of acres was entirely wrong. I have corrected the quantity of acres, and now return to Land Office, by request of the heirs of David Carskaddon dec^d.
