



A Draft of a tract of Land situate on the North Branch of Dunning's Creek Called Bob's Creek, partly in Greenfield and St Clair townships. Bedford County containing six Hundred and seventeen and one half Acres and allowance of six per cent for roads & so - surveyed for Frederick Snyder on Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1763.

No 1 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Henry Wertz on Warrant dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1785. This tract Interferes with the Frederick Snyder survey - Eighty Two acres Henry Wertz conveyed to William Proctor who also bought from Dr. Smith and others who claimed under Frederick Snyder. William Proctor conveyed to John Garn who devised part ther-of to John Garn Jr. the present owner the residue he devised to Frederick Garn whose Administrator conveyed to John Cristman the present owner
