



The above draft of Survey represents Tract No. 58 of 200 acres in the 1st District of Donation Land in Shenango Township Lawrence County Pa. with metes & bounds & contents as marked thereon. It is said to be an undrawn tract and was settled by James Wilson as such about 50 years ago. and with the exception of about 16 perches in a deep ravine it is all fenced & is generally cleared. I found upon the tract the families of Mrs. Sarah Rigby claiming about 77 acres & representing the heirs of Archibald Cubbison Decd. Mrs. James Wilson & Albert Wilson claiming about 68 acres. Robert Johnson claiming about 34 acres & Frederick Leffler claiming about 28 acres representing the heirs of James Wilson Decd.

It was surveyed on the requisition of the heirs of James Wilson and Archibald Cubbison. the subdivision marked on the draft was shewn by their representatives as made by themselves
