- A, B,** Surveyed on Warrants of 29 March 1797 to Ellis & Thomas Martin, both run into and interfere with Older Surveys Warranted to John M. Pherson and W. Shirliff, represented by dotted lines.
- C,** Surveyed on Warrant of same date to Robert Martin, and which runs in to W. Shirliff, an older Survey as pr dotted lines.
- D,** is part of John Reed, Warrt. of June 21, 1786, which also runs into and interferes with W. Shirliff, a part of this Reed tract is within the lines of C Bitners farm, and a part in the Farm of Mauk & M. Clintock.
