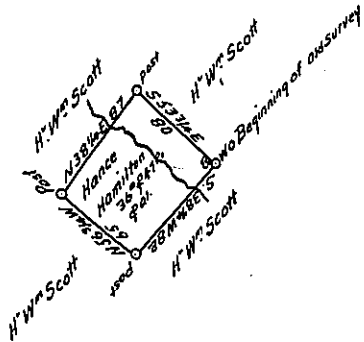


Situated in Hamilton Bann Township York County and Surveyed the Sixteenth Day of December 1794

Situated in Hamilton Bann Township York County and Surveyed this 16th day of December 1794 in pursuance of Warrant for 50^o Granted to Hance Hamilton the 1st day of April 1751 which had been Surveyed by Francis McCulloch deputy for George Stephenson on the 1st day of April 1751 as marked on said McCulloch's Field Book but not returned as I am informed.

The Guardians inform me that when they applied for the above mentioned Warrant (in trust) they did not know of the One in right of Hance Hamilton which is here included in the whole Survey
