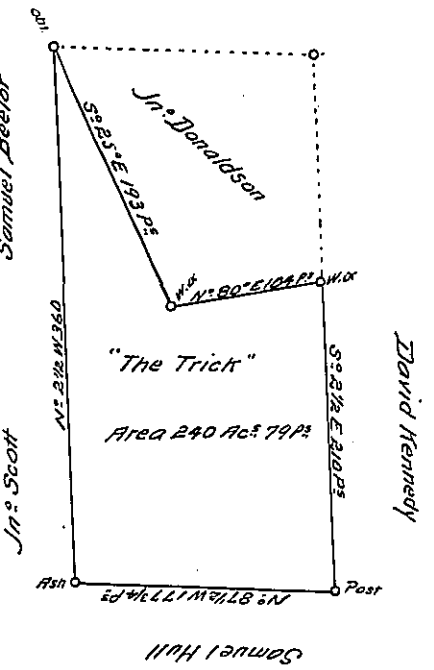


Note J. Donaldson

A Draught of a Survey called "The Trick" situate between Robinson's Run and Raccoon Creek in Washington County contg. 240 Ac: 79 P: and the usual allowance for Roads &c executed June ye 23rd 1786 for Francis Kirkpatrick Ass^{es} of Jos. Link and And^{rs} Blunk in Pursuance of a Warr^t granted to s^{rs} Link and Blunk (ob^d) 300 Ac: dated Mch ye 19th (ob^d). Note this survey is included in one made Oct 21st 1785 on a warr^t in the name of Jn: Donaldson dated Sept ye 10th 1785 at the time of making Donaldson's Survey and long since Kirkpatrick claim'd another Tract with his warr^t and applied to us to execute it for him, but on elder right intervening; and finding his Warr^t to be elder than Donaldson's and descriptive of the Land, he has changed his Ground at his pressing request we make this Return.
