



The shaded lines in the above diagram represents a Survey which was made to Humphry Fullerton the 1st of June 1775. By wart. of the 23^d of July 1773 situate on a branch of the Allegheny is found to lie on little Mahoning Creek north of the purchase of 1768 and in the purchase of 1784 in Mahoning Township in the County of Indiana. The dotted lines represent the surveys on which the land is claimed the warrantees the dates and the numbers whereof are inserted in the drafts respectively. The said interference ascertained the 16th of May 1828. In pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by authority from the Board of property.
