And by Virtue of an Order of Survey dated 1st August, 1766, No. 530 granted John Montgomery for 200 acres "joining south by Robert Miller, south east by Benjamin Alsworth, east by William Greenlee in Lurgan Township

Report. The part of the above tract marked A, was surveyed 9th May 1768 on an order to Benjamin Alsworth dated 17 October 1766, No. 2870 and held under said title. The part of the tract marked B is included in a survey of 256 a. 116 ps. made 12 Feb'y, 1790, on Warrant to John & Robert Watson dated 19 Dec'r, 1785. Note the part B. laid off agreeable to a draft found in office on which was endorsed the order to John Montgomery
