



Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Antrim township, Franklin County containing eighty seven acres one hundred & thirty two perces & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary rights &c.
