Located in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property (for ascertaining, surveying and returning unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c &c) And by virtue of an order of survey dated first of August 1766, No. 195, granted to Joseph Conrad for 300 as "Lying in Hamilton Township bounded by John Campbell on the south east and land claimed by John Burns on the North east." N.B. No evidence of the above described Order being previously executed on the land or of any person now claiming under the same Report: The above described tract is part of a larger tract of 187a.33ps. & allowance Survey'd 23d. of May 1787 on a warrant to Josiah Allen dated the 4th of <sup>February</sup> ~~March~~, 1785. Note, the survey of Josiah Allen embraces in addition to the above Tract; the figures marked A & B. Pat'd. Note, the part of the above tract marked C. was formerly included in a survey of 326 1/4 as to John Burns on Warrant dated — Note, The figure A. was survey'd & returned on an order to John Burns dated 12th November 1767, No. 4571, & returned: not pat'd. Note, The dotted figure B. was survey'd & returned on an order to Robert Hartford dated 30 June 1767, No. 4076 for owners & occupiers see Book No. 2 not Pat'd.
