Surveyed the 8th of September 1829 (on an application granted James Scott for 120 as. of land in Peters township joining John Erwins improvement, William Deans including timber land lying between Thomas McDowell & William McConnell to the N. W. of their improvement dated the 1st of August 1766 No. 523.) In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary rights &c.
