



Situate in the forks of the East and Middle Branches of Standing Stone Creek between John Curry and Andrew Boggs in Barree Township Huntingdon County containing one hundred and fifteen and one half acres and allowance of six per cent surveyed for Mathias Leman on order No. 1322 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1766 To Jacob Spangler Esqr. 5 6 Daniel Africa D. 5

No. 1 represents part of a survey made for John Gregory on warrant dated the 8th day of November 1784 This survey interferes twenty one acres with the Mathias Leman tract John Gregory conveyed to John Cay the present owner

John Gregory Pat'd Thomas Covenhoven not Pat'd Charles Fichtels not Pat'd No. 2 is a survey made Thomas Covenhoven on warrant dated the 7th<sup>th</sup> day of November 1816 This survey interferes thirty acres and seven perches with the Mathias Leman tract Thomas Covenhoven is the present owner

No. 3 represents part of a survey made for Charles Fichtels on warrant dated the 5th day of August 1794 This survey interferes sixty four acres and seventy three perches with the Mathias Leman survey Charles Fichtels conveyed to Fesin Fichtels who conveyed to Hezekiah Crowmover the present owner
