



A draft of a tract of land situate in Wayze township, Mifflin county containing 196 a 77 perches and allowance &c surveyed April 26th, 1803 for James Stachpole in pursuance of an Application in the name of John Mc Cormick for 200 a No. 4859 dated the 18th day of March 1768 Per William Harris D.S.

All contained within the black lines on the above draft is in the above mentioned 196 a 77 ps. The part marked No 1 represents a survey made for Wm Humphreys on the 15th January 1791 said to contain 70 as in pursuance of a warrant dated 9th March 1787. The small part marked with black strokes shows part of a survey made for John Warefield 9th August 1784 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 1st July 1784. The dotted lines through the above survey show a survey of 70 a 105 ps which appears to have been made 1st March 1775 in pursuance of a warrant dated 25th October 1774 for Samuel Holliday
