



A Draft of A tract of land situate on Town Creek in Southampton Township Bedford County containing one hundred and sixty nine acres and twenty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Joseph McKinney the 20th day of March 1767 on Order No 2895 dated the 24th day of February 1767.

No. 1 represented by dotted lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Jonathan Hambleton the 5th day of April 1797 on Warrant dated the 20th day of April 1793. This tract interferes ninety two acres and eighty six perches with the Joseph McKinney survey. Jonathan Hambleton conveyed to John Rowland who conveyed to Phillip Crow the present owner.

No. 2 represented also by dotted lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Jonathan Hambleton the 5th day of of April 1797, on Warrant dated the 1st day of September 1794. This tract interferes seventy perches with the Joseph McKinney survey. Jonathan Hambleton conveyed to John Rowland who conveyed to Phillip Crow the present owner.

N.B. Phillip Crow claims the residue of the Joseph McKinney Survey by virtue of a settlement made in the year 1791 by Michal Crow. Which settlement right Michal Crow conveyed to Phillip Crow the present owner.
