No. 1 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of A tract of land surveyed for Robert Callender on Warrant dated the 7th day ~~eight~~ of July 1762 this tract interferes forty eight acres and one hundred and twenty five perches with the Archibald McCallister survey. Robert Callender conveyed to Gerard Pendergrass who conveyed to Gideon Ritchey who conveyed to Anthony Smith the present owner.

No. 2 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Mathew Taylor on warrant dated the 24th day of March, 1794. this tract interferes fifty one acres and one hundred and thirty perches with the Archibald McCallister survey. Mathew Taylor conveyed to George Woods who conveyed to Henry Smith who conveyed to John Pepples whose executor conveyed to Jacob Shoemaker the present owner.

No. 3 represent by the dotted and black lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Michal Ott on Warrant dated the 16th day of May 1793. this tract interferes seventy eight acres and one hundred and twenty five perches with the Archibald McCallister survey. Michal Ott conveyed to Jacob Shoemaker the present owner. James O'Connor D.S. To Gabriel Heister Esqr. S. G
