 with the Thomas Mc Costrey tract. James Bartley conveyed to William Peters who conveyed to Richard Peters
 who conveyed to George Keller the present owner.

No. 2. represented by one dotted one black and late colored lines is part of a draft of a tract of land survey-
 ed for Jacob Tarwater on the warrant dated the 19th day of January 1785 this tract interferes three acres and six
 ty six perches with the Thomas Mc Costrey survey. Jacob Tarwater conveyed to Henry Lyberger whose heirs
 are the present owners.
