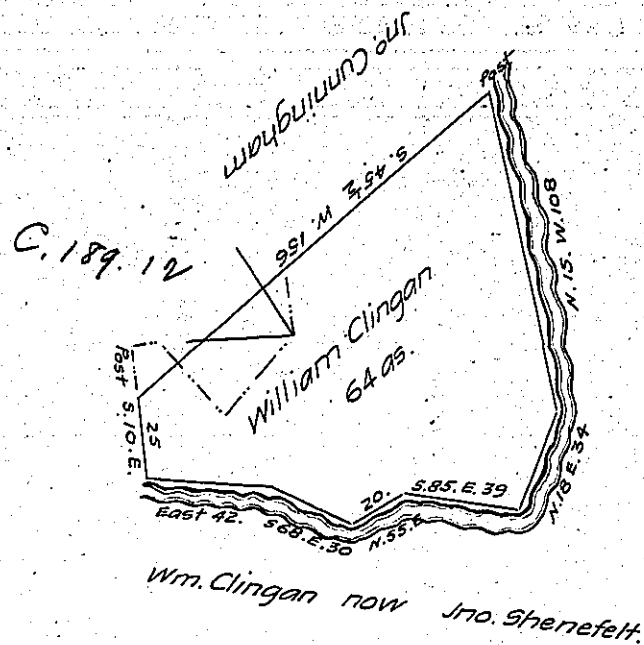

Situate on the North Side of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta in Walter township township, Huntingdon County containing sixty four acres and allowance of six per cent for roads - Surveyed for William Clingan on order No. 1291, dated 19th September 1766. Daniel Africa D.S.

The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for John Cunningham on warrant dated the 13th day of December 1770. This tract interferes fifty nine acres and seventy one perches with the William Clingan survey. John Cunningham conveyed to Cabob and Amos Foulke from whose heirs it was sold by the sherriff to Joseph Patton who conveyed to John Patton who sold to John Ridenour who devised the same to his son John Ridenour the present owner.

The purple lines represent part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for John Ridenour on warrant dated 26th January 1815. this tract interferes one acre and fourteen perches with the William Clingan survey. John Ridenour devised the same to his son John Ridenour the present owner.
