



A Draught of A Tract of Land situate on the West Branch of Stone Creek in Barree Township Huntingdon County  
 Containing Two hundred and two acres and thirty nine perches and allowance of six per cent for Floods & so  
 Surveyed for Mathias Slough on Order No. 1316 dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of September 1766  
 To Jacob Spangler Esqr. S. G. Daniel Africa D. S.

The dotted lines represent a survey made for James Dickson on Warrant granted to him dated the 20th day  
 of September 1762. This tract interferes forty three acres and one hundred and twenty one perches with the Mathias  
 Slough tract. James Dickson conveyed to Col. John Armstrong from whom the same was sold by the Sheriff to John  
 Montgomery who lost the same at law with Wm. Mc Elavey who claimed under Andrew Boggs Jr.

The red lines represent a Survey in the name of Andrew Boggs Jr. on Order No. <sup>1302</sup> ~~1325~~ dated the 20th Septem-  
 ber 1766. This tract interferes Two hundred & two acres and thirty nine perches with the Mathias Slough tract  
 Andrew Boggs Jr. conveyed to William Mc Elavey who devised the same to his heirs the present owners  
 J. Dickson, not found No. 1302, pat'd.
