The figure marked B represents a survey of 44 a. 139 ps. on a warrant to George Stinger & James McCalmont dated 27 March 1788. The figure marked C represents a survey of 28 a. 112 ps. on a warrant to Christian Shankt. bearing date 15 of June 1772. The figure marked D represents a survey of 33 a. 98 ps. on a warrant to John Barnhill dated 4 April 1775.
