 Situate in Manhime township York County, surveyed in pursuance of an Application No. 1143 granted to John  
 Stevens dated September the 8th, 1766. the above tract of land is owned and in possession of John Leinert.  
 Part A is included in a patent granted to Henry Leinert on the 9th day of April, 1788, on a warrant granted to a  
 certain Jacob Huntzacher dated the 23rd day of October 1749. And part B is included in a patent granted to Jacob  
 Huntzacher on the 11th day of October 1750 on a warrant to him dated March the 1st, 1744, but no evidence of  
 Stevens (the name of the Office Right) ever being in possession or ever claimed it. Surveyed May 30th, 1831.
