



A Draft of A tract of land situate on the waters of the Raystown Branch of Juniatta, partly in Bedford & Napier townships, Bedford county, Containing one hundred & sixty one acres & allowance of six per cent for Roads & So. Surveyed for John Morris the 8th day of May 1770 on Order No. 245 dated the 6th day of August 1766.

No. 1 represented by the green lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for John Nixon in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 25th day of October, 1765. This tract interferes one hundred & sixty one acres with the John Morris tract. John Nixon conveyed to Charles Coxe who conveyed to John Sills and Hill Wilson the present owners.

No. 2 represented by the dotted lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for John Fraser the 9th day of December 1765 in pursuance of A Warrant dated the 10th day of August, 1765. This tract interferes one acre and forty perches with the John Morris tract. John Fraser conveyed to Mess Baynton & Wlarton who conveyed to Richard Neave Senr. and Richard Neave Jr. who conveyed to Auther Mc Gaughy who conveyed to William Wilson who conveyed Hill Wilson whose heirs now own the land.
