The figure marked B is included in a survey of 308 a. 101 ps & a l. made 1 May 1769 on Order to Thomas Barrett dated 2d July 1767, No. 4108, & the figure C is included in a survey of 307 a. 95 ps made 1 May 1769 on Order to George Goodwin dated 2 July 1767, No. 4107. Note The part A owned & occupied by Francis McConnell under his order the part C by Jacob Wilhelm under title to Goodwin & the part B claimed by Robert McCormack. Note The red lined figure D represents the survey of George Goodwin, and the dotted figure E that of Thomas Barrett. W. S. D.
