



Situate on the East side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniata in Porter township, Huntingdon County Contain-
 ing Two hundred and thirty three acres and ninety eight perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads. Surveyed
 for Daniel Longstreet on order No. 620 dated the 1st day of August 1766.

William Anderson. not returned

The dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed for William Anderson on warrant
 dated the 6th day of October 1825. This tract interferes two hundred and thirty three acres and ninety
 eight perches with the Daniel Longstreet survey. William Anderson lost this land at law with the heirs
 of David Magaw who claimed under Daniel Longstreet.
