Bryer dated 22d April, 1794 & held under said title. The part marked B containing 60 acres & a1. is wholly the same as a tract purporting to be 64 a 111 ps & a1 survey'd 22d Nov'r 1805 on an order to Wm Mc. Bryer dated 4 March 1767, No. 2978 & held under said title. Note. No evidence of possession in M. Wilson or of any person claiming under said order to Wilson. W. S. Davis
