In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c. William Hamilton Wm S. Davis Contractors To Jacob Spangler Esqr. Sur. Genl. The land above described is held by the following rights the part marked A containing 96 as 62 per & all. is part of a tract of 222 as 110 per & all. which was surveyed on a warrant granted James Bigger dated the 23d of Feby 1773, the part marked B includes a survey of 33 as 53 per & all. which was surveyed on a warrant granted James Bigger dated the 20th of Feby 1775, The part marked C includes a survey of 78 as 77 per & all. made on an application granted Hugh McTee dated the 13th of October 1767, No. 4482 there is no evidence of any survey having been made on the application of Joseph Herr Jacob Lemaster part, Jacob Myers part, Jacob Overs heirs part, Jacob Myers, John Myers & Jacob Overs heirs occupiers Peters township J. Bigger Part Pat'd Same Pat'd No. 4482, Pat'd
