

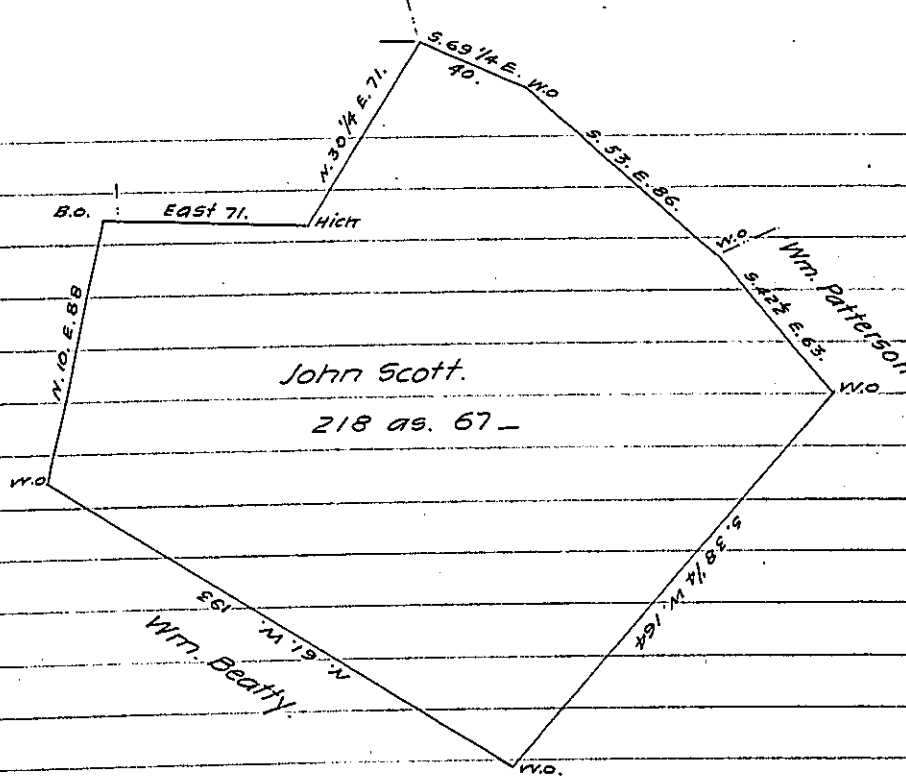

No 1 represented by dotted lines is a part of the draft of a tract of Land surveyed for John Scott on Warrant dated the 25th day of January 1796. This tract interferes two hundred and forty five acres and fifty five perches with the Mary Bractenridge survey. Mary Bractenridge conveyed to John Scott who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and conveyed to Jacob Shimer whose administrator conveyed to Ludwigh Florey the present owner.

N.B. below is annexed a the draft of the survey made for John Scott on the aforesaid warrant which draft covers all land covered by the above draft. but the interference cannot be laid down on account of the difference of distances as returned in both drafts when it is evident that they should be the same
