



Pursuant to a warrant from ye Proprietors Comiss^{rs} of Prop^{ty} Dat- 25th 12^{mo} 1701. directed unto me I Certiefy that I have re-
 asurveyd unto myself having in Company Griffith John and James Davis Daniell Harry and James Per two
 certaine tracts of land the one begining at a stak-set in the ground in a line deviding it from John Longworthy's land and
 being a corner deviding it from John Richards land from there by a line of marked trees west south west 168 perches
 to another stak deviding it from ye said Worthys land from there by a line of marked trees and some land Nor: Nor: West
 132 perches to a stak-in a heap of ~~3~~ stones from there by a line deviding it from the Reputed land of Ellis Joanes,
 east nor: east 168 perches to another stak-~~in~~ being a corner deviding it from ye said John Richards land from there by a
 line of marked trees & same land S. S. East 132 perches to the place of begining containeing 138 acres of land with another
 tract of land begining at a stak-being a corner deviding it from Griffith Johns land from there by a line of marked
 trees nor: nor: west 112 perches to a stak-set in the ground being a corner deviding it from John Kinseys land from ye by
 a line of marked trees and same land east nor: east 526 perches to a stak-neere a whit-~~of~~ marked from there
 south south east by a line of marked trees 112 perches to another stak-being a corner deviding it from ye reputed land
 of ye Widdw. Benet from there by a line of marked trees and same land and ye said Griffith Johns land west south west
