Upon the Application of Joseph Gronson to the Comm^{rs} on the 20th of the first Month 1715/6 complain^t of divers disappointm^{ts} in laying out his City Lots & being kept out as he alledged from taking up the Lands due to him by the Prop^{rs} Concessions for importing above forty servants on his own Acc^t into this Province.

In Consideration whereof & of his publick Services to this Governm^t the 5^d Comm^{rs} granted him a warrt for taking up 2000 acres of land within this Province at 1st sterl^a of Cent Quit Rent which was surveyed to him in two tracts.
