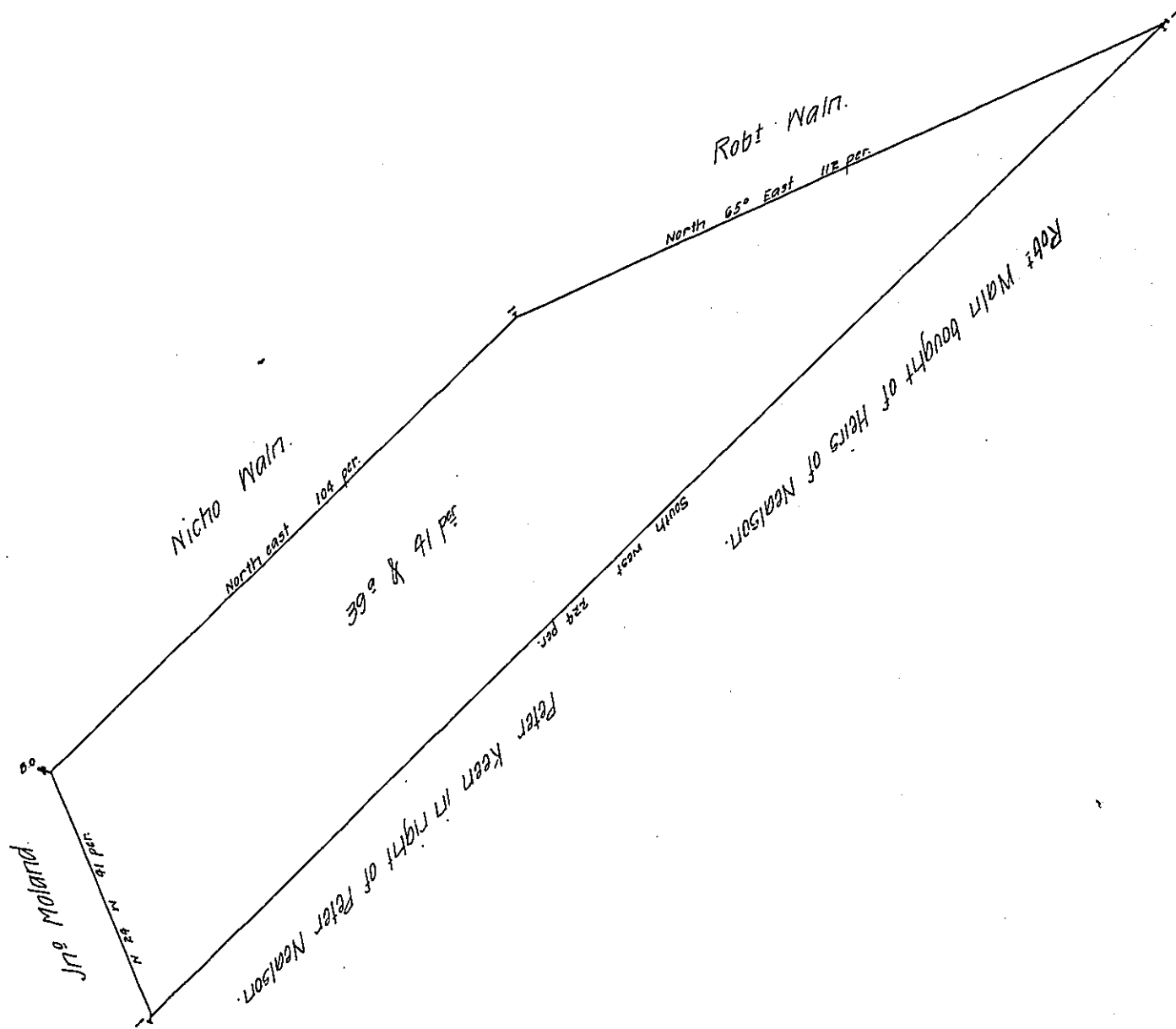


Scale 20 to an Inch.



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries bearing date the Twenty ninth day of June 1750 I have surveyed to Mr Isaac Norris the above described tract of land situate in the Towns^R of the Northern Liberties of the City of Philad^a Beginning at a Black oak sapling in Moland's Line thence ^{by Nicho Waln} north east 104 per to a stake thence by Robt Waln N. 65. E 112 per to a post thence by other land of Robt Waln's formerly Peter Nelson's & by land of Peter Keen, formerly the afo. s^d Nelsons south west 224 per to a stake in Moland's Line thence by Moland's Line N 24. 41 per to the first mentioned Black oak Contain^g 39^a & 41 perch-
