



The division line is removed 10 per. at one end and 12 at the other which with the 2 p. increase in the breadth makes Snowden's about 432 ac. as I suppose but I refer the quantity to Jacob — the lines are as here given.

A new draught of John Snowden and Peter Worrall's land where I have certified there Division not altogether according to thy direction in thy letter, but by consent of both parties (by much persuasion;) Peter claims 220 ac. by purchase and saith he was first purchaser and John can have but the remainder; At last they concluded by consent to run the line as it is in this Draught (which I did) and I think they be both contented. I have placed the course and distance upon the lines only where I have altered them and do desire Jacob Taylor to rectifie the Returne accordingly. I have prick'd the old line between them and Henry Marjorurn, and also Peter's fence that thou may see the reason of that turne in the new line to keep off his Improvement as thou didst direct. There division was so unrequall at first that I could not rectifie it by Marjorurn's line without making them Irregular, I should but have taken 1/3 of Marjorurn's deficiencies out of Peter's of which I took almost 1/2 and yet it is unrequall, I told them so at first but they replied they were satisfied with the division between them. I finde the division line to be 2 perches longer then I gave it in the returne, which was for want of due regards to the 52 perches which follows the old line varying 2 deg^{rs} to the north which gives 2 perches more to the sd line.
