



By virtue of a warrant from Jacob Taylor Surveyor Gen^l to me directed bearing date the 22^d of the first month 1709. Pursuant to a warrant from the Commission^{rs} to the s^d Jacob Taylor dated the 21st of the 1st month 1709 to resurvey & divide a certaine tract of land lying neare Southampton township in the County of Bucks, Laid out unto Samuel Finney (Assignee of Dove Wiggins & Samway a certaine part of the s^d tract Beginning at a great black oak at Evan Griffiths corner, from thence west 4 deg^s north 506 perches to a post by s^d Evan Griffith & Joseph Webb's land, and so on as upon the draught, laid out the 10th 6th 1709.

By virtue of the warrants before mentioned laid out unto John Clark (Assignee of John Pennington) a certaine piece of the afores^d tract Beginning at William Cutler's line & Stephen Whiting's line by a black oak in ~~the~~ thence by William Cutler's land N 4^d N 21 1/2 perches to a ^{small} black oak, and so on as upon the draught. And also another piece Beginning at a post in Samuel Finney's line thence N 4^d N 253 perches to a small Hickory in George Willard's line, and so on. Laid out unto Daniel Wharley a certaine part of the s^d tract Beginning at a stone by a run at a black oak in ~~William Cutler's line~~ thence by ~~the~~ William Cutler's land N: 4: N 21 1/2 p. to a black oak, and so on; and likewise another piece Beginning at a post at Samuel Finney's corner, thence by s^d Finney's line N 4^d N 253 perches to a post and so on as upon the draught. All laid out the 10th of the 6th month 1709.
